20.07 Chorley Council Tax Support Consultation

A proposal for parish councils to contribute a small amount towards council tax support for low income claimants which would result in a negligible reduction in the amount of precept received was considered.

Resolved: the contribution was agreed.

20.08 Precept

The Precept for 2020-21 was considered. A revised draft budget was presented resulting in no increase in the Parish Council portion of council tax to residents. The revised budget took into account the potential council tax support contribution,

Resolved: the Precept for 2020 - 2021 was set at £8867, holding the cost of the Parish Council portion of council tax to residents.

20.09 Central Lancashire Local Plan Issues and Options Consultation

A consultation by the Central Lancashire Authorities relating to suggestions for potential housing sites was discussed. A request that any site to be taken forward should take into account impact on local infrastructure, including school places, availability of healthcare facilities, public transport and drainage (including run off generated by new properties is to be submitted.

20.10 Neighbourhood Priorities

Councillors discussed potential priorities to be submitted once the new council wards have been implemented. A suggestion for a planting scheme in the White Coppice picnic area, based on the report provided by the professional gardener, was put forward as a possible priority.

20.11 Chorley Liaison Meeting

Suggestions for agenda items for the next meeting were invited. An item covering the possible provision of Electric Vehicle Charging Points in rural areas is to be requested.

20.12 Newsletter Delivery

The newsletter is to be published to include an item on the Local Plan issues and Options consultation. Councillors are to provide the Clerk with photos for the contact page. Delivery arrangements were confirmed.

20.13 Heapey Chase Flooding Issues

There were no major issues and the lack of rain recently had resulted in the path to the rear of Blackbrook Close drying out.

20.14 Reports from Outside Bodies

Heapey and Wheelton Village Hall - bookings are satisfactory and improvements to the heating system are being looked into.
